God our saviour, look on this wounded world in pity and in power; hold us fast to your promises of peace won for us by your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ.

Readings for Sunday 16th June:

Psalm 20

¹ May the Lord hear you in the day of trouble, • the name of the God of Jacob defend you; ² Send you help from his sanctuary • and strengthen you out of Zion; ³ Remember all your offerings • and accept your burnt sacrifice; ⁴ Grant you your heart's desire • and fulfil all your mind. ⁵ May we rejoice in your salvation and triumph in the name of our God; • may the Lord perform all your petitions. ⁶ Now I know that the Lord will save his anointed; • he will answer him from his holy heaven, with the mighty strength of

his right hand.⁷ Some put their trust in chariots and some in horses, • but we will call only on the name of the Lord our God. ⁸ They are brought down and fallen, • but we are risen and stand upright.⁹ O Lord, save the king • and answer us when we call upon you.

Mark 4.26-34

²⁶ He also said, 'The kingdom of God is as if someone would scatter seed on the ground, ²⁷and would sleep and rise night and day, and the seed would sprout and grow, he does not know how. ²⁸The earth produces of itself, first the stalk, then the head, then the full grain in the head. ²⁹But when the grain is ripe, at once he goes in with his sickle, because the harvest has come.' ³⁰ He also said, 'With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable will we use for it? ³¹It is like a mustard seed, which, when sown upon the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth; ³²yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes the greatest of all shrubs, and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade.' ³³ With many such parables he spoke the word to them, as they were able to hear it; ³⁴he did not speak to them except in parables, but he explained everything in private to his disciples.
